The Programs

Our programs have been designed with the primary school classroom and busy teacher in mind and where appropriate include many useful features which are indicated by the symbols shown.

ELECTRONIC **BLACK-BOARDS** Use your BBC micro as a sophisticated teachina aid. Electronic Blackboards allow the teacher to present the educational content of the program on screen in a manner and speed suitable to the group they are teaching. The 'Electronic Blackboards' are particularly helpful when used with the children before they work through the rest of the programs.

PRE-SELECTING PLAYERS AND GAMES Type in the names of children to be called up to the com puter and given a game or practice at any of the available levels of difficulty. Using this option the computer can be set up to run for a whole session without further teacher intervention.

TEACHER CONTROL All programs are fully adjustable. Where appropriate speed, sound, levels of difficulty, number of retries, passwords etc. can be easily altered by the teacher if the normal settings are not required.

RECORD SECTIONS You can see how children have performed at the end of a session, often with a detailed analysis to enable the teacher to pinpoint any problems.

MAGIC E: BBC Model B Age Range 6 to 9 years

Disc or Cassette

This program is intended to teach and practise 'Magic E' using simple words and pictures. It includes all the standard facilities and options available in 'Short Vowel Sounds' (see above).

Special features include:

A teaching section which is intended for use as an electronic blackboard. The short vowel sounds actually lengthen when Magic E appears providing a strong visual illustration of its effect.

A diagnostic section, using words and pictures which will record the results of up to five pupils for later reference.

A final assessment based on a story and utilizing a cloze type procedure.

The Electronic Blackboards can be used as a teaching aid while the 'pre-defined players and games' option allows the teacher to set up the program to call up a series of up to ten sets of children to play specific games. WORD BUILDER Mk II: BBC Model B Age Range 5 to 9 years

Disc

This is a completely revised version of our program 'Word Builder'. It includes the very comprehensive phonic lists that were included in the original version but has many, many more features including:-

'Wordchop' a very appealing, animated game for 1, 2 or 3 players. Children have to guide 'Mr Chop' to the right place and then split words into their phonic components. Corrections are given in a meaningful manner and in tests the game has proved to be very effective in helping children identify phonic sounds.

The phonic word lists included on disc range from initial consonants and short vowel sounds right through to vowel digraphs. 'Word Builder Mk II' has to be one of the most comprehensive phonic programs available!









Language Development

EASY TYPE: BBC Model B Age Range 5 to 9 years

Disc

This program was written by Margaret Hayball, the author of the popular 'Mr Yog and the Nippet'. It is an invaluable aid to the infant, lower junior and remedial teacher. Using 'Easy Type' the teacher can build a word list for each of his/her pupils that contains all the words in their look/say vocabulary. The list can be added to at any time as the child learns to recognise more words. It can be displayed on screen in large, lower case letters and by using only six keys, the pupil can select any of their words to build sentences, or simple stories, on the lower half of the screen. This provides a quick, easy and exciting way for the child to 'write'. This instant success is a confidence booster to even the most hesitant pupil. As the child progresses she can type in her own words and 'Easy Type' becomes an infant word processor. Linked to a printer the childrens' work can be printed out as many times as required. The program becomes even more versatile when used by the imaginative teacher to produce class word lists. For example:- Topic word lists, rhyming lists, lists of adjectives, verbs etc. for creative work, maths word lists (e.g. shapes) and so on . . . You are only limited by your own imagination!



INVISIBLE INK: BBC Model B Age Range 7 to 13 years

An exciting new program for junior schools. Invisible Ink is an intriguing game that offers practice in many aspects of reading, comprehension, spelling and grammar. It allows teachers to hide any part of a text for children to try and discover. Words. parts of words or even punctuation and numbers can be written in 'invisible ink'. Letter clues can be 'bought' from the computer and points are scored by correctly quessina what is written in 'invisible ink'. The program comes complete with a number of text files to illustrate its numerous uses. As new text files can easily be created by the teacher, Invisible Ink can be used to complement any language or topic work a class is doing. 'Ink Print' which accompanies Invisible Ink even allows printouts of the text you create, so that you can duplicate your own worksheets. Text is entered and saved in the comprehensive Teacher Control menu which also allows full adjustment of the sound, starting scores and time limits. It also allows teachers to enter the names of up to five groups of children to be called up to the computer to play the game and keeps records of all scores. In this way the program can easily be set up to 'run itself' for a lesson without further teacher interaction. MATHS SNAP: BBC Model B Age Range 7 to 13 years

Cassette and Disc

INFANT MATHS SNAP: BBC Model B Age Range 4 to 7 years

Cassette and Disc

Infant Maths Snap has six different games to help children understand and learn about numbers up to 20. It consists of two programs. The first has four games in it dealing with sets, numbers and number names. The second has two games dealing with split sets showing simple addition and subtraction. All games can be played by one or two children. The Teacher Control menu in both programs allows full adjustment of the number range, time allowed, number of questions, number of games per player and sound. The programs include 'electronic blackboards' to use as a teaching aid and an option to pre-define players and games. This allows the teacher to set up the program to call a series of children to play specified games at appropriate levels and keeps a record of their scores for the teacher to view. The programs are presented with colourful graphics and large lettering.













TENS & UNITS: BBC Model B Age Range 6 to 9 years



Disc

This very comprehensive program has been designed to help children understand tens and units. It includes an animated teaching section where a set of 'units' is displayed on the screen and then divided into tens. Each ten is coloured differently by the child and then moved across the screen to form a tens column. By answering the questions and watching the animation children very quickly grasp the concept of place value. Corrections are given when required to help the learning process. The children can then progress through three colourful and exciting games designed to consolidate and extend their knowledge, culminating in the very popular 'Safe Cracker!' The numbers used in the program are presented in as many different ways as possible to promote understanding. The Teacher Control menu allows the program to be tailored to the needs of individual pupils and the Electronic Blackboards can be used for group tuition. In classroom tests 'Tens & Units' has proved to be very effective indeed.













WIZARD'S REVENGE, a Mathematical Adventure on BBC

Age Range 7 to 11 years

We were delighted when a primary teacher in Gloucester submitted the 'Wizard's Revenge' for publication as we rate it very highly. It is an adventure program which takes about 40 to 90 minutes to complete. The program has been written so that it falls naturally into two parts which can be tackled separately to fit in with the busy school timetable. 'Wizard's Revenge' comes complete with teachers' notes and an illustrated booklet for the children which sets the scene for the adventure. While on holiday with Aunty and two friends, a day on the beach turns into a real adventure when the children are asked to help rescue a mythical king who is imprisoned on his own island by a wicked wizard. During their adventure children face a series of varied mathematical problems including shape, symmetry, co-ordinates, time, money, multiplication, etc. The graphics are excellent and it should provide a wealth of experience in decision making, planning, logical thinking etc. It is recommended that two or three children play together and when this happens even more in the way of co-operation, team work and language results. Add to this the scope for follow up work and you've got a real winner with children and teachers alike!





Language and Maths Activities

MR YOG & THE NIPPET: BBC Model B

Cassette and Disc

Age Range 4 to 7 years

Mr Yog just loves to eat apples. Every day he walks along paths and climbs up ladders to get to his apples. The wicked Nippet puts obstacles in his way to stop him. Children can help Mr Yog to get to his apples by selecting the right answer in ten different maths and language activities. You and the Nippet consists of two programs. 'Word and Letter Games' include letter recognition and discrimination and rhyming words and/or pictures. 'Number Games' include sets, numbers, number names, addition and subtraction all up to nine. The addition and subtraction games include illustrated corrections. Both programs are fully adjustable from the Teacher Control menu and can be set up to call a series of children up to the computer to play the games. They are presented in appealing graphics and with optional sound effects.

THE CIRCUS: BBC Model B Age Range 4 to 7 years

Another of Margaret Hayball's aems. 'The Circus' is her first in a series of topic based programs for the infant school. It can be used either as the central theme for a topic on the circus, to complement another topic or simply in its own right. The discincludes five different programs which include a wealth of language and maths activities all based in 'The Circus'.

'Make a Circus' allows children to simply build up their very own circus on the screen and then make it perform! Jugglers juggle, Clowns clown, the band plays, in fact everyone does their piece! Screens can be saved at any time to be recalled at a later date. Children who have been testing this program have been fascinated by it. It pro-

vides hours of language stimulating activity.

'Clown Snap' is a beautifully simple game that very young children love. Matching the different shapes that make up the clown's face leads to a very pleasing reward! 'Custard' is a wicked game that can start children squealing with delight. Press your key for a snap in three different games matching pictures with words, numbers and colours and watch your custard pie grow. Losers had better beware!!

'The Strong Man' needs help! Children have to balance his weight in six different mathematical activities from one to one correspondence through to simple addition and

subtraction.

'Circus Count' is a very simple counting program for children who are just beginning with numbers. Using the Circus pictures they simply have to match the number of pictures with the correct numeral.

The comprehensive Teacher Control menu allows full adjustment of the programs.
